Description

Prepare your sumi-e and/or calligraphy for framing by adding a seal and mounting them. This workshop covers:

- How to carve a seal script on a stone.
- How to mount your work with special backing paper called mino-paper.
- How to make traditional glue, used for mounting masters' pieces for hundreds of years and still used in museums for restoration.
