

# Introduction to Drawing – Elizabeth Selna

## **Materials List**

#### **Mediums:**

- 1. Black India ink 2 oz
- 2. Charcoal: vine and willow (soft)
- 3.2 Char-Kole brand square sticks compressed charcoal, (soft)
- 4.2 General's charcoal 4B & 6B
- 5. Conté Sticks: Soft, white and black
- 6. One of each of these graphite pencils (2H, HB, 2B, 6B)
- 7. Black India ink 2 oz
- 8.1 Dip pen nib holder with 2 nibs (tips), fine and medium)
- 9. Black felt-tipped marker, fine point

#### Tools:

- 1. A sketchbook 8" x 10" or larger
- 2. One kneaded rubber eraser
- 3. Pencil sharpener
- 4. Staedler plastic eraser for pencil
- 5. Newsprint pad , 18" x 24"
- 6. Medium White Drawing Pad,18" x 24" (Appropriate for ink, charcoal and graphite) 7. One chamois
- 8. Watercolor or Japanese brush (size 6 or larger with a good point.)
- 9. Toned charcoal or pastel paper, 2 pieces (tan, medium gray and black)
- 10. Drawing Board
- 11. 3 large clips with which to keep the pages of your drawing pad from moving
- 12. Any box in which to carry your drawing materials
- 13. Recycled plastic container for water
- 14. Inexpensive 12" ruler
- 15. Workable fixative for charcoal 16. Hand wipes for ink/charcoal.

#### Adhesives:

1. Glue, painter's tape, and etc

### **Clothing:**

- 1. Gloves
- 2. Smock or apron (protects clothes from charcoal dust)
