

Painting Landscapes and Portraiture - INT - Gary Bergren

Materials List

- 1. Watercolor Pencils (Burnt Umber)
- 2. Eraser (Preferably a white eraser made with Magic Rub)
- 3. **Paints for Landscape** Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red light, Cadmium Red Medium (optional), Veridian Green, Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Ultramarine Blue (or Cobalt Blue), Cerulean Blue, and Prussian Blue.
- 4. Paints for Portraits Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow Light, Yellow Ochre, Cadmium Red light, Cadmium Red Medium (optional), Alizarin, Terra Rose, Burnt Sienna, Ultramarine Blue, and Black (optional)
- 5. Brushes Buy a few small rounds (#0, #3 preferably), filberts (#3, #6, #8, or #14), one fan brush
- 6. Mediums Drying Linseed Oil, and baby oil or an odorless turpentine such as Turpenoid to clean brushes
- 7. Canvas Preferable sizes for class are 11 X 14, 14 X18, or 16 X 20. A canvas board is also acceptable. 8. Masking tape
- 9. Paper towels
- 10. Standard Color Wheel
- 11. A palette of your choice such as paper pallet
- 12. Pallet Knife

Additional Information

- Consider some type of plastic container to put your palette within to retard the drying time of
 your paints. Many art stores carry one made by Masterson, which has a blue cover/top and
 white bottom which is made for this purpose.
- Bring a picture of interest to paint (bring more than one choice just in case), and an easel (optional) of your choice.
