



Intro the Abstract – Jody Mattison

Materials List

- The materials are of your choice; at least have some drawing media, some painting media, drawing/painting surfaces, and (unless you are using oil) acrylic matte medium. Raid your art supplies for a nice variety.

1. **Suggested Paint is Acrylic** (substitutions are fine, at least have a good representation of the color wheel)

(Oil, watercolor and gouache can all be used to different effect. Oil will take longer to dry)

Titanium White, Cadmium Yellow Lemon or other Green - Yellow, Cadmium Yellow Light or other Orange – Yellow, Cadmium Red Light or Hue, Quinacridone Rose or Permanent Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Cerulean Blue or Hue or similar, Viridian or Hue, Payne's Gray or Carbon/Ivory Black

2. **Suggested Mediums** - Useful for acrylic, watercolor, gouache, drawing media and collage- Clear Gesso (made by Liquitex)

Fluid and/or regular Matte Medium and Gloss Medium. Can be thin glazing fluid or thicker. Krylon workable fixative or similar.

3. **Suggested Mediums** - Useful for oil paint and oil pastel

Clear Gesso (made by Liquitex) can make a nice surface to draw and paint on Turpenoid. Liquin, Galkyd, or Galkyd solvent free gel plus Linseed oil.

4. **Basic and Possible Painting Surfaces (Size is optional)**

Canvas board or stretched canvas, mat board coated with acrylic size and clear gesso (demo in first class), gessoed mdf panels, heavy watercolor paper, good cream or white drawing paper, pastel paper, cardboard, etc. Make sure to have at least some sketch or drawing paper for the first day.

5. Basic and Possible Drawing Media

Graphite pencil, vine charcoal, charcoal pencil, watercolor pencil or crayon, prismacolor-type colored pencil, pastel pencils, Nupastel or Conte, chalk pastel, oil pastel, crayon, pen and ink, marker, etc. Make sure to have at least some charcoal or graphic pencil the first day.

Additional Information

- **Suggested Tools and Supplies:**

For Painting - Brushes of different sizes, palette knife or knives, palette or container for paint, rags or paper towels For Everything but Oil Media: spray bottle of water (should have a spray or mist setting) For Drawing: Kneaded Eraser, white plastic eraser, sharpener for pencils, old pencil or brush for scoring into paint.
