



Nature-Based Watercolor Painting – Elizabeth Selna

Materials List

1. **Basic watercolor paint:** Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow, Lemon Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Black & White
2. **Watercolor brushes, rounds preferred, (student grade):** Small, Medium & Large & a Wash Brush
3. Watercolor paper: 9" x 12"
4. Mixing palette, white plastic, medium-sized, (with separate wells for mixing)
5. Pencil, Eraser & Ruler
6. Medium-sized board for taping watercolor sheets down to prevent buckling, (e.g. sheet of hard cardboard a bit bigger than 9" x 12" (can be recycled) or light wooden board.
7. Recycled plastic containers for water, paper towels & masking tape
