Materials List

- 1. Sketchbook of student choice, 7x10 or 9x12, with unlined paper. (\$10–15)
- 2. A set of drawing pencils, including at least 1 of each of the following: an HB pencil, H pencil, B pencil, 2B pencil, and 3B pencil, as well as a simple mechanical pencil. (\$10-15)
- 3. Two Pigma MICRON ink pens, size 02 (\$6 for 2; these also come in various packs if you can't find individual pens)
- 4. Two kneadable art erasers (\$2-3)
- 5. One pencil hand-held pencil sharpener, preferably with a well to catch shavings (\$2-12)
- 6. A basic set of 12 colored pencils including at least 1 red, yellow, green, blue, and black. I recommend the Blick Studio Artists Colored Pencil set (\$10 on their website) Or

Prismacolor Premier colored pencils (set of 12 \$15-25, available at most art supply locations.)

Additional Information

- Students may wish to explore mediums other than colored pencil, including acrylic or watercolor paint, pastel, or others. You're welcome to bring your own mediums and supplies for this purpose!
- All materials (unless otherwise noted) may be purchased at any supply and craft store, including Michaels, Blick, or off Amazon. The teacher encourages students or guardians to shop locally when possible (but I ain't judging).
- My personal favorite store is FLAX, locally owned and operated, with locations in Oakland and San Francisco. They also ship locally: <u>Flax Art</u>
