Materials List

Students must have these materials for the first class. All Items should be available at Stained Glass Garden, call to check availability. Students also receive a student discount. You can check with the other listed sources also.

1. 1 or 2 packs of Mandrels 3/32" x 12" (Stainless Steel Rods)
2. 1 Mandrel Release **flame dry type** (to coat Mandrels)
3. 1 MAPP GAS available from hardware store (fuel for torch)
4. Coffee can 1/2 filled with rice (to hold dipped mandrels)
5. Assorted Glass Rods COE 104 (MORETTI) ONLY
- Colors of your choice, don't get too much of any one color until you see what it does. I also recommend you get a selection of both opaque and transparent colors
